Sean grew up in Aliquippa, and is a 1976 graduate of Quigley High School where he was a four year letterman in wrestling and a 3 year letterman in football. He is a graduate of Slippery Rock State College. Sean is currently in his 26th year of officiating high school and college wrestling. He is an active member of the PIAA and Pittsburgh Chapter of Wrestling Officials. His work as an official includes 14 National High School Championships, 5 PIAA Championships, 22 Regional Championships, 22 WPIAL Championships, 23 Section Finals, 19 Dapper Dan Classic Events, and 24 years as a MAC Championship official. All total, Sean has officiated over 1600 dual meets and 250 tournaments. He has worked for 27 years as a senior sales engineer for John Crane Inc.
