The following are criteria for nomination:

1. Student is a **sophomore, junior, or senior**
2. A minimum cumulative **GPA of 3.0 or higher** on a 4.0 non weighted scale
3. Wrestler's 2009-10 **season varsity record of .600 or better**
4. Wrestled a **minimum of 15 varsity matches this season**
5. Completed application with **school seal and necessary signatures**
6. **Transcripts** from school's guidance department with the application
