PWCA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

What is a PWCA Scholarship?

PWCA Scholarships provide financial assistance to high school seniors who exhibit excellence in a well rounded educational and extracurricular program. The scholarships are made possible by the Annual PWCA Convention and Clinic, and are administered by the PWCA Scholarship Committee.

Who is eligible for a PWCA Scholarship?

Any current high school senior wrestler who is enrolled in a public or accredited private school in PA. Has attained a 2.0 cumulative grade point average (GPA) non-weighted based on a 4.0 scale for the three previous academic years. (Grades 9, 10 and 11). And are planning to continue their education beyond high school in an accredited institution of higher education or a technical school.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The PWCA Scholarship Committee will consider the following for the purposes of awarding The \$1,000 scholarships.
 - A. Academic Achievement 25% (GPA and Class Rank)
 - B. Athletic Achievement 25%
 - C. Essay Contest 50%
- 1a. The \$500 Scholarships are based solely on the essay.
- May be used at any institution of recipient's choice Education program must be designed to take one or more years to complete.
- 3. Recipients will be announced in June and receive a letter from the PWCA. A list of all winners will be sent to their guidance counselors. Non-recipients will not be notified.
- 4. All winners must submit a certificate of admission or letter of acceptance to the Scholarship Committee by July 1s. No letter, No Scholarship!
- Scholarships can be used for tuition, books, laboratory fees and other academic costs, room and board.
- 6. A check will be sent to the individual upon receipt of receipts for books, tuition, lodging, computer etc. The check will be sent when the receipts are received by the PWCA.
- 7. If a recipient leaves the institution and there are PWCA Scholarship funds remaining, the institution shall return the balance to the PWCA
- 8. If a scholarship winner must delay their education for any reason, the scholarship will be held for up to 2 years from the date of high school graduation.
- 9. The PWCA will be awarding two \$1,000 scholarships for the total application and 4 \$500 scholarships based only on essay content. The same person cannot win both.
- All applications must be received by March 31st of the year in which they are awarded.
