Team PA battles with Team NJ at Princeton University

This past weekend, Pennsylvania was invited to bring an all girls team to do battle with Team New Jersey at Princeton University. NJ scheduled matches at their major in-state universities over the weekend as a way to showcase girls wrestling. PA took on NJ between Princeton matches with ivy league rivals Harvard and Brown, and on Sunday, NJ battled NY just prior to the Princeton vs. Rutgers battle in North Jersey.

Both PA and NJ were well represented with a host of Fargo and National Tournament place finishers and over 35 state titles amongst girls on the teams. PA came away with a 51-38 win in what was a very exciting match in front of several hundred Princeton fans.


