BIG 33 and EAST WEST ALL STAR GAMES
NOMINATION APPLICATIONS IN THE MAIL

Nomination forms for coaches and players for the 2007 Big 33 and PSFCA East West All Star Games have been sent the members of the Pennsylvania Scholastic Football Coaches Association. Over 600 coaches received the mailing which also included forms to nominate the 2007 PSFCA Hall of Fame inductees.

“Coaches are strongly encouraged to complete their player nomination forms along with game tapes and send them to the PSFCA office by the December 4 deadline. These two games are known for having the best of the best Pennsylvania high school football players competing in their last game before moving on to college. With the caliber of talent we have seen across the state this season, these two games in 2007 are sure to live up to that reputation.” commented Garry Cathell, President of the PSFCA.”

PSFCA members will also be making their recommendations for the coaching staff for the games. The Big 33 Head Coach will come from the West along with four assistant coaches. The East West Game will have two head coaches who will each have five assistant coaches. The East West Game added an additional assistant coach to each staff at the request of the coaches during their annual review meeting in 2004 which takes place the morning of the game.

Game coaches will be selected at the PSFCA December Meeting. Players for all three squads will be selected in January. The Big 33 game will be played on June 16 in Hershey and the East West Game will be played on Saturday, June 23 at Mansion Park in Altoona, PA.
