

Roundup of Week 10 Action

Northern Cambria 7, Ligonier Valley 0

The Colts (7-3) advanced to the quarterfinals of the D6-A playoffs with their second straight shutout over the Mounties. Northern Cambria will now face top-seeded Purchase Line (8-1) on Friday. Andy Paronish scored the only touchdown of the game on a 4-yard run. The Colts held Ligonier Valley to just 120 yards of total offense.

Laurel Valley 35, Blacklick Valley 6

The Rams (7-3) rushed for a combined 276 yards and 5 TDs, while the defense limited the Vikings (4-6) to just 114 yards of total offense in a D6-A playoff game on Saturday. Laurel Valley advanced to the quarterfinals against No. 2 seed Southern Huntingdon (8-1) on Friday.

Glendale 36, Conemaugh Valley 14

Derek Nash ran for 110 yards and Gary Walstrom scored three touchdowns to lead the Vikings (8-2) to the D6-A playoff victory over the Blue Jays (4-6) on Saturday. The win was the first playoff victory for Glendale ever. RB Robert Gunby led Conemaugh Valley with 222 yards rushing and two TDs. The Vikings will face No. 3 seed Bellwood-Antis (7-2) on Saturday.

Harrisburg 32, State College 27

RB Deries Hodge ran for 184 yards and three touchdowns, the last one coming on a 68-yard run in the fourth quarter that gave the Cougars (9-1) the victory over the Little Lions (8-2). Harrisburg clinched its first ever Mid-Penn Commonwealth championship and the top seed in the District 3-6 Class AAAA playoffs. State College quarterback Brook Hart passed for 198 yards and three touchdowns.

Huntingdon 41, Central Mountain 6

Tim Rohrer scored three touchdowns and surpassed the 1,000-yard mark for the season as the Bearcats (9-1) defeated the Wildcats (5-5). The loss eliminated Central Mountain from the District 3-6 Class AAAA playoffs.

Tyrone 35, Johnstown 7

The Golden Eagles ended the regular season unbeaten at 10-0 with a convincing victory over the playoff-bound Trojans (7-3). Tyler Golden passed for 153 yards and two touchdowns, both to Justin Schopp, who finished with four catches for 121 yards. Tyrone RB Tyler Gillmen ran for 114 yards and 2 TDs.

Chestnut Ridge 15, Bedford 13

The Lions (7-3) defeated the Bisons (6-4) for the first time in 19 attempts after Bedford missed on a two-point conversion with just over a minute left in regulation. Mike Tomovich rushed for 118 yards and a TD for Chestnut Ridge. Jesse Feaster ran for 108 yards and a score to lead Bedford.

Altoona 40, DuBois 7

The Mountain Lions (7-3) head into the District 3-6 Class AAAA playoffs with some momentum after picking up their fourth straight win. Reggie Mencer ran for 118 yards and four touchdowns, while D.J. Patterson intercepted his 11th pass of the season for Altoona.

Penn Cambria 68, Bellefonte 34

Matt Holsberger ran for 220 yards and three touchdowns and Jon Mulhearn added 125 yards and a score to lead the Panthers (9-1) to the victory. Penn Cambria QB George Klayko was a perfect 8-of-8 for 150 yards and four touchdowns as the Panthers scored on their first seven possessions. Red Raiders QB Ryan Poorman threw for 273 yards and four touchdowns. Bellefonte wideout Matt Fisher had nine grabs for 140 yards and a touchdown.

Forest Hills 44, Karns City 21

Rangers quarterback Travis Rearick completed 13 of 21 passes for 234 yards and four touchdowns to lead Forest Hills to a win over the previously unbeaten Gremlins (9-1). Forest Hills (8-2) got 112 yards rushing and two touchdowns from Jared Kostan, while Ross Carpenter had eight receptions for 125 yards and a score.
