

Blue Devils, Little Lions Move on to PIAA Semis

PIAA Playoff Football Results:

Bellwood-Antis 28, Steelton-Highspire 8

Josh Kleinfelter rushed for 240 yards and four touchdowns to lead the Blue Devils (11-2) to their first PIAA playoff win ever with a convincing win over Steel-High (11-3). Kleinfelter became the all-time scoring leader in Bellwood history with 79 career touchdowns. The senior passed the 2,000-yard barrier for the second straight season. The victory moved the Blue Devils into the PIAA Class A semifinal round — which is also the Class A eastern final — next weekend against four-time defending state champion Southern Columbia at a site and time to be determined.

State College 21, Governor Mifflin 0

Little Lions QB Brook Hart passed for 114 yards and two touchdowns and ran for 139 yards and a score to lead State College (12-2) to its first ever District 3-6 Class AAAA championship over the Mustangs (12-2) on Saturday. It's now onto the PIAA semifinals for the first time since 2003. The Little Lions will face WPIAL champion Upper St. Clair (14-0) at 1 p.m. Saturday at Mansion Park Stadium. The State College defense held Governor Mifflin to only 153 total yards and forcing three turnovers.

Wilmington 13, Bishop McCort 6

Scott Lewis ran for 132 yards and a touchdown, but it wasn't enough as the Greyhounds remained unbeaten at 14-0 to advance to the PIAA semifinals against Jeannette at a site and time to be determined. The Crushers ended their season at 11-2 overall. Chris Burns led Wilmington with 96 yards rushing and touchdown.
