Games of the Week

North Penn 17 - SJ Prep 7 – It appears as though the mighty Prep rushing game, which averaged over 200 yards a game on the ground in 2006, could only manage 73 against North Penn, as the Knights overcame the hype that is the Prep and downed the PCL runner-up.
