Games of the Week

Roman at Brooklyn Poly Prep, Sat, 7:00PM – Roman has decided to take the route that Prep and O'Hara has taken the past few years. Go out of state and find some top teams to test your talent. Unfortunately, this game is out of state, so we'll have to wait to see how they do later.

Don Bosco (N.J.) at SJ Prep (Plymouth-Whitemarsh), Sat, 7:00PM – This is the second year in a row that Prep has played nationally ranked Don Bosco Prep. Last year, Bosco won a squeaker by a score of 31-28 up in NJ. This season, Bosco travels to our side of the river to take on the Prep at Plymouth-Whitemarsh.
