Week 5 in District 10 saw another streak fall and 2 more teams exit the ranks of the unbeaten. In Conneautville, The Indians of Conneaut Valley ended their 15 game losing streak in fine fashion as they throttled the visiting Youngsville Eagles 31-7. Eisenhower and Seneca saw their undefeated seasons come to end, losing to Maplewood and Harbor Creek respectively. Week 5 also saw Farrell and Oil City get their initial wins of the 2006 season.

Region 1 'A' saw blowouts across the board. Farrell rode the legs of freshman tailback Lamont Hailstock to a 42-14 rout of Cochranton. Sharpsville rushed for 400 yards as a team earning them a 38-16 home victory over Conneaut Lake. Lakeview continued their solid play by pounding Linesville 45-8. Kennedy Catholic traveled across the border to Warren, Ohio to play JFK and took a 42-7 loss without starting QB/FS Ross Gargano. Senior QB Kolten Hoffman went over the 3,000 yard career passing plateau and West Middlesex remained undefeated by taking out Mercer 42-0.

Region 2 'A' witnessed a prodigious losing end for the second week in a row when Conneaut Valley defeated Youngsville 31-7. Cambridge Springs got back to winning by defeating winless Union City 28-0. Maplewood, after suffering 33 straight defeats, got its 2<sup>nd</sup> win in a row by downing previously unbeaten Eisenhower 20-14. Merceryhurst Prep made an 80 yard run by Jayson Nickson stand up in beating Saegertown 7-0 and Iroquois gave 'AA' Girard everything they wanted before succumbing 21-14.

Region 3's frontrunners Wilmington and Sharon stayed undefeated by beating Reynolds (37-0) and Greenville (6-0) respectively. Grove City used a punishing ground attack led by the 200+ yards rushing by Junior Chris Clark to beat Hickory 24-12.

Region 4 saw now has a 3-way tie for first by way of a Harbor Creek win over Seneca. Corry bounced back from last weeks loss to Seneca by defeating North East 21-7. The game was clinched when defensive back Brandon Eck picked off an option pitch and went 85 yards for a score. Fairview kept Fort LeBoeuf winless handing the Bison a 34-7 setback.

In the only game in Region 5 action, Oil City garnered its first win of the year with a 19-13 overtime upset of Franklin.

Region 6 saw Cathedral Prep pound East 55-7 and Strong Vincent rush for nearly 600 yards in pounding Warren 53-14.

In D-10 out of conference action, McDowell defeated District 7's Butler 20-7. Northwestern kept Meadville winless with a 20-7 win. General McLane put up a mind-boggling 475 yards on just 22 carries in blowing out Slippery Rock 62-17 and finally, Titusville shutout Central 35-0.
