Athens 17 - North Penn 16

Davaun Stedge had 71 yards on 14 carries and a TD. QB Shane Raupers gained 31 yards on seven attempts, completed three passes for 24 yards in the win, scored a TD and game winning 31 yard field goal. RB Nate Townsend led Athens with 94 yards on 14 carries. Athens defense came up strong in the win.

North Penn got 73 yards from Riley Bowen on the ground and 56 yards along with a TD from Levi Weiskopff, while Harris completed three of nine passes for 35 yards in the loss. A 12-yard touchdown pass from Justin Harris to Brian Strange along with a safety completed North Penn scoring. Mark Fidler returned a kickoff for 72 yards.

Wyalusing 22 - Muncy 21

Darren Mahoney found Derek Otis open in the back of the end zone with :38 left to play to bring the Wyalusing Rams to within 21-20 of the host Muncy Indians Saturday night before Mahoney ran in for the two-point conversion to give the Rams a 22-21 win. He also threw TD passes to Dan Howard and two to Derek Otis. Muncy QB Kyle Hill tossed two touchdown passes to Eric Lehman and a TD pass to Thaddeus Martin.

Towanda 21 - Canton 7

Adam Harris finished the game with 152 yards on 22 carries while Jake Lamphere had 31 yards rushing and threw for 20 yards in the win. Towanda running back Eric Potter gained 112 yards on 16 carries and scored a pair of touchdowns in the Black Knights' 21-7 win over Canton. The senior also threw a 38-yard touchdown pass on a halfback option and he had a key interception late in the victory.

Reese Holmes threw for 66 yards in the loss and Nick Petrowsky gained 32 yards, while Tyrell Wheeler had 20 yards on the ground and Lucas Bailey had 24.
