Tunkhannock 20 - Athens 13

Tunkhannock's Dustin Faux ran for 238 yards on 32 carries including 2 scores to lead 14-13 at half. John Benko hit Daugherty for a 47 TD to start the 3rd to go ahead 20-13. Nate Townsend led the Wildcats with a TD and 90 yards. Davaun Stedje had a TD and 63 yards. QB Shane Raupers was 8-13 with a TD to Brett Coyle. Coyle had 5 grabs for 41 yards.

Waverly 56 - Sayre 13

Waverly Wolverines put together an impressive showing in a 56-13 victory. Jeff Velardo finished with 80 yards on the ground and Rick Lynch had 68, while Colin McDonald ran for 60 yards. PJ Grego picked up 31 yards on the ground and Josh Kennedy ran for 21 yards. Mark Kuzma was six-for-11 passing for 75 yards and Scot Sinsabaugh had three grabs for 44 yards, while McDonald and Lynch each had catches. Sayre got on the board in the third quarter when Andy Podolinski broke off a 52-yard scoring run and the Redskins got another score in the fourth when Mike Cooley scored on a 3-yard quarterback keeper. Podolinski led Sayre with 81 yards on the ground, Richie Villenti had four catches for 52 yards and Anthony Villanti added a grab as Cooley was seven-for-14 passing for 92 yards.

North Penn 28 - Canton 14

North Penn had a dominating defensive performance in a 28-14 win over Canton. Riley Bowen finished the day with 23 carries for 184 yards and he caught two passes for 50 yards. Justin Harris was six-for-14 for 89 yards and Brian Strange added a catch, while Tyler Rumsey finished with three grabs for 25 yards. Levi Weiskopff had 75 yards on 15 carries and Cody Groover ran for 21 yards, while Mark Fidler had 15 yards rushing. For Canton, Nick Petrowski had 32 yards on the ground, while Tyrell Wheeler ran for 15 yards and Lucas Bailey had 14 yards on the ground. Strange and Casey Kurzejewski each had two interceptions for the Panthers in the win.

Troy 42 - Montgomery 14

Chance Wright was the star of the night for the Trojans, racking up a career-best 163 yards on 18 carries and scoring a 26-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter. The Trojans racked up 342 yards on the ground in the first half. Vance Spencer had 35 yards on the ground and David Conklin had 32 for the Trojans.

The upperclassmen also had a strong day as Matt May racked up 118 yards on nine carries and Brad Morgan had 90 yards on 14 carries. Tony Carter added an interception for Troy.

Towanda 43 - Wellsboro 0

Towanda scored early and often with Eric Potter scoring 3 TD's and finishing the game with 128 yards on the ground. Adam Harris ran for 80 yards and a TD, while QB Jake Lamphere had 41 yards rushing along with a passing TD to RJ Baker. Lamphere was three-for-four passing for 41 yards and Dakoto Roof was one-of-two through the air and also kicked a 27 yard field goal. Harris had two grabs and Baker and Zach West each had one. Jesse Tom ran for 66 yards on 10 carries for Wellsboro and Tim Shaw ran for 24 yards, and was five-for-19 passing for 27 yards. Cameron Jones had one catch for 21 yards and Chet Johnson added a 9-yard catch.

Wyalusing 27 - Cowanesque Valley 7

QB Derek Otis finished the game completing 6-of-14 passes for 219 yards with a pair of touchdowns and an interception. Jimmy Chadwick led the Rams' receiving corps with three receptions for 152 yards and a touchdown. Nick Kellogg led the Rams in rushing with 57 yards on 6 carries. For CV, Cameron Wattles

completed 4-of-14 on the night for 11 yards with an interception and Mitch Balfour hauled in one pass for eight yards. Anthony Tommaro led the Indians in rushing with 83 yards on 21 carries with a touchdown.
